PHARMACIST

One of the jobs I am considering to be when I grow up is being a pharmacist. A pharmacist is a person who distributes proscrition drugs to individuals. They monitor the health and progress of individuals to ensure safe and effective use of their medication.

They also have a major role in compounding, which is the mixing of ingredients to form medication.

A pharmacist normally works 40 hours a week. They work in drug stores, department stores, hospitals and pharmaceuticals. The level of education is a doctor of pharmacy degree. The yearly average starting salary is \$94,520. The range of yearly earnings is \$83,180 - \$108,140.

Some other jobs that are related are pharmacy

technicians, pharmacy aids, biological scientist to just name a few.

INTERIOR DESIGN

An interior designer decorates homes, building, and spaces using style, color, and the use of furniture to make that space that meets the customer's needs or preferences. An interior designer has to be able to read blueprints, and use their time and budget carefully.

The number of people that had jobs in this field was 72,000 in 2006 and is expected to increase. Some of the industries that interior designers work with are landscapes, and architecture. The qualifications that are preferred are a postsecondary education, or a bachelor's degree. There are 2 year and 3 year programs available.

The average yearly starting salary is \$42,260. Other occupations that are related are architects, fashion designers, floral designers, graphic designers, and landscape architects.

RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGIST

A radiologist technologist is a person who takes x-rays, administer nonradioactive materials into patient's blood stream for diagnostic purposes, and can perform CT and MR scans. They work around 40 hours a week. A danger in the field is that you are around radiation.

The number of people in the occupation is around 196,000. Radiologic Technicians work in hospitals, offices, labs, and med centers. The number of jobs in this occupation is increasing.

The average yearly starting salary is \$48,170. The range of the yearly salary is \$39,840 - \$57,840. Other occupations that are related are cardiovascular technicians, diagnostic medical sonographer, nuclear medicine technologist, radiation therapists, and respiratory therapists.
