For education you should have either a Bachelor's or Master's degree in Fine Arts. You'll also need a creative mind. Your starting salary will depend on what field of arts that you go into. Craft Arts \$18,860-\$35,840, Fine Arts \$28,500-\$58,550.

Writers

You get to express your creative mind, while either painting a story to a reader about something that really happened or making it up. The hours can be irregular, especially if you have to get it to the Editor.

They work in comfortable private offices or rooms. One of the most irritating things for Writer's, might be getting 'Writer's Block.'

In 2006 they held 306,002 jobs. You're going to need an education in Communications, Journalism, and English. The salary you get yearly is between \$25,430-\$97,700..

Actress
